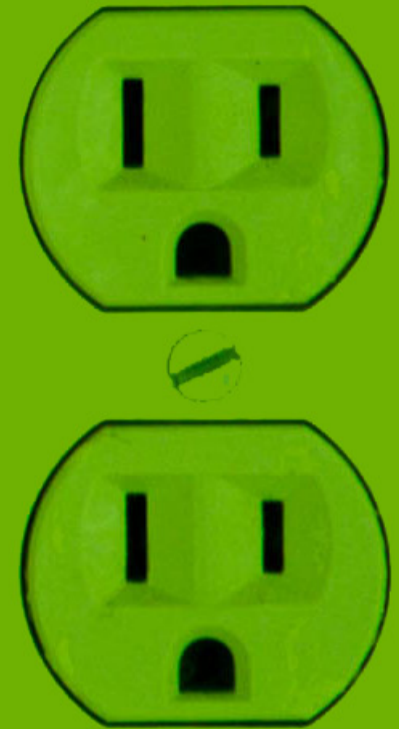


# Energy Transition and the 2030 Agenda: Shaking Up the Energy Mix
